### ABSTRACT

The Ghana Cash-Based Intervention (CBI) Post-Distribution Monitoring (PDM) survey, conducted by UNHCR between January 24th and February 9th, 2022, evaluates the impact of cash-based assistance provided to forcibly displaced and stateless individuals in various locations across Ghana, including Aflao, Ho, Hohoe, Kadjebi, Krisan, and households living outside of camps. The survey covers 634 individuals from 133 households. Households received cash assistance based on their size, with smaller households (1-3 members) receiving an average of GH¢ 158 and larger households (8+ members) receiving GH¢ 250.5. The data informs the effectiveness of cash-based interventions and guides future support for forcibly displaced and stateless individuals.

## Sampling

**SAMPLING PROCEDURE**

The sampling method used is probability sampling, specifically stratified sampling. Households were divided into strata based on specific characteristics, such as location (Aflao, Ho, Hohoe, Kadjebi, Krisan, and out-of-camp households) and household size. A total of 133 households, encompassing 634 individuals, were selected for the survey to ensure representative coverage of the forcibly displaced and stateless individuals benefiting from cash-based interventions.
