ABSTRACT

The dataset encompasses anonymized microdata from a post-distribution monitoring survey conducted by UNHCR. As the lead of the protection cluster, UNHCR provided cash assistance to refugees in settlements across Local Government Areas in Cross River and Benue States, Nigeria, in early 2019. The primary objective of this assistance was to support the economic inclusion of refugees and meet their various needs. To evaluate the effectiveness and efficiency of this cash-based intervention and to gather feedback from the beneficiaries, UNHCR carried out a post-distribution monitoring survey between July 25th and 30th, 2019. The survey involved interviews with over 1,140 recipients of the cash assistance in the states of Benue and Cross River. The data collected includes detailed insights into the utilization of the cash assistance, the beneficiaries' experiences, and the overall impact of the intervention. The dataset is classified as sensitive due to the detailed nature of the information, but it only contains anonymized data to protect personal information and is accessible under licensed use. This dataset is crucial for program monitoring and evaluation, providing valuable information to improve future cash-based interventions. The data collection followed a stratified random sampling procedure based on location and household size, ensuring a representative sample of the refugee population. Data was collected through face-to-face interviews, ensuring the accuracy and reliability of the responses.
