ABSTRACT

The South Sudan: Results Monitoring Survey (RMS) 2023 is a household-level survey conducted by UNHCR to monitor key impact and outcome indicators among refugee returnees and internally displaced persons (IDPs). The survey, carried out across 41 counties in 9 states, uses computer-assisted personal interviews (CAPI) to gather data on mobility, disability, housing, basic needs, safety, income, and gender-based violence. A total of 6,266 households were surveyed using a simple random sampling method. The data, collected between December 2023 and February 2024, is integral to assessing the progress of UNHCR's operations in South Sudan. Rigorous daily data reviews ensured high quality, and the results provide a robust evidence base for guiding humanitarian interventions and reporting to key stakeholders.
