The Refugee Economies, Cross-country Dataset, Refugees Only combines household survey data from six separate data collection exercises conducted between 2016 and 2018. The survey aimed to assess the socio-economic outcomes of refugees in various regions of Kenya, Uganda, and Ethiopia, covering indicators such as income, expenditure, health, education, and migration. The findings contribute to understanding refugees' economic lives and the determinants of their socio-economic inclusion.
