Objective:

3. To provide guidance for UNHCR WASH 2019 interventions and future sustainable WASH programming for Rohingya refugees;
4. UNHCR Bangladesh WASH interventions able to compare to UNHCR Global KAP standards.

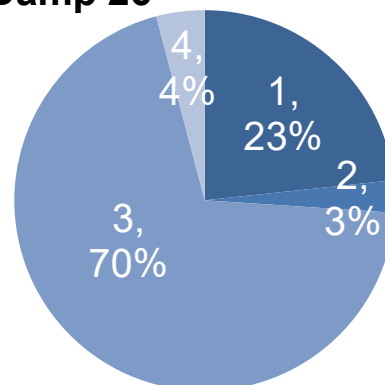


B.1.a What is the PRINCIPAL source of domestic water for members of your household?



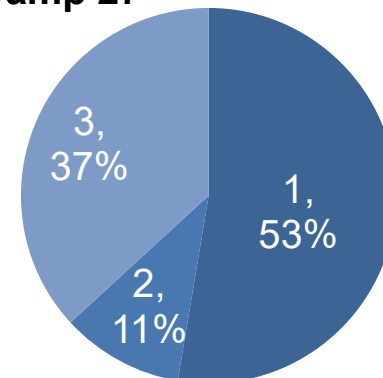

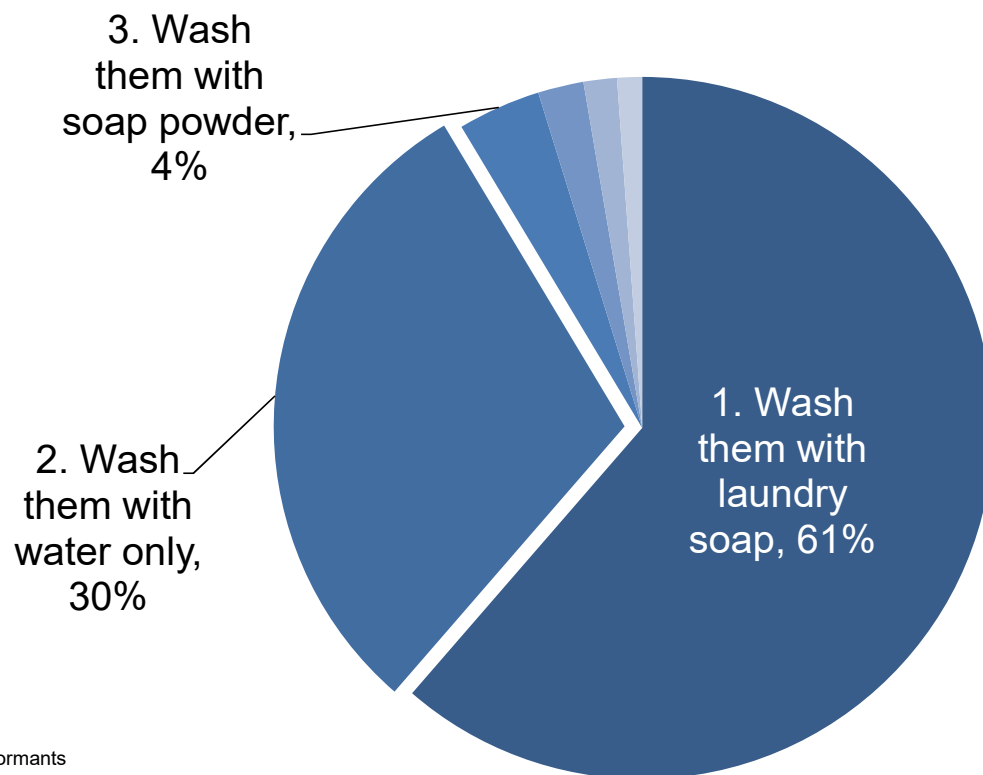


B.9.a. How often do you clean your drinking water containers?
